Massaging each other: great. Tandem massage: even better. So share the love by sharing a spa day—or weekend! Destination spas like Ontario's world-renowned Ste. Anne's Country Inn & Spa (spavillage.ca) offer couples side-by-side massage treatments such as in-room chocolate massages. Follow a day of pampering with on-site fine dining—in your robes, no less!—then slip away to the grotto for a quick dip before tucking in by the fireplace for the night.

On the West Coast, retreat to Vancouver Island's rainforest at Clayoquot Wilderness Resorts & Spa's Bedwell River Outpost (www.wildretreat.com). Overlooking Quait Bay and surrounded by ancient cedars, the spa boasts an outdoor shower, waterfall-fed pool, cedar hot tubs and meditation decks. Good times—that is, if you can pull yourself away from your tented suite. Featuring Adirondack-style beds, opulent area rugs and remote-controlled propane wood stoves, this is the kind of camping high maintenance partners won't mind.

For a more invigorating experience, check out the Nordic spa at Québec's L'Eau à la Bouche (leualabouche.com), nestled in the picturesque Laurentians. Enjoy the fresh mountain air as you hop between therapeutic outdoor hot and cold baths, then catch your breath in the steam room and sauna. Later, treat yourselves at the resort's spa, which uses Canadian skin care line B. Kamins, Chemist, beloved by both women and men for harnessing the exfoliating, rehydrating and protecting powers of the maple tree. After taste-testing the kitchen's best, take to your adorable room and bask in your mutual glow.
